CENTRAL FLORIDA – As Hurricane Ian continues to move closer to Florida, it’s important to know where you can go in the event of an evacuation.

If possible, it’s recommended to go to the home of a friend or family member who lives outside of an evacuation zone, however, if you cannot do that there are other options.

Some hotels offer ‘distress’ rates for those in need of a place to stay during weather emergencies. But, if worst comes to worst, it is important to know where the closest evacuation shelter is to you.

If you have to go to an emergency shelter, you should bring:

- Blankets and pillows
- Snacks
- Extra clothing
- Any necessary medications or oxygen supplies
- Toiletries
- Flashlight and batteries
- Electronic devices and charges
- Diapers and other infant necessities
- Important documents such as IDs, birth certificates and social security cards.

As Florida prepares for Hurricane Ian, counties across the Tampa Bay area have started to open shelters for those in mandatory evacuation zones. **This list will be updated.**

GENERAL SHELTER INFORMATION

Seminole County Office of Emergency Management will open shelters with ample time to evacuate. Emergency shelters should be used as a last resort.

Residents with special medical needs should register for the [Special Needs Registry](#) in order to evacuate to a medically-enhanced shelter.

Select shelters will be pet-friendly.

BEFORE EVACUATING YOUR HOME:

Before arriving at a shelter, make sure your home is protected. Learn more about how to [prepare your home for a storm here](#).

WHAT TO BRING TO A SHELTER:

Each person receives a 7' x 3' space. Ensure belongings fit within the designated space. Be sure to bring:

- Bedding (cot, blanket, pillow)
- Personal medications
- Food for any special dietary needs
- Comfort/entertainment items
- Identification
- Extra clothing

SHOULD YOU GO TO A SHELTER?:

If you live in a mobile home and/or if your home is in a low-lying area or flood zone, consider evacuating.
